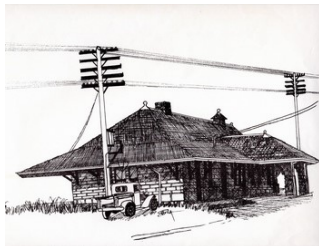

#999 at Euclid Beach Park

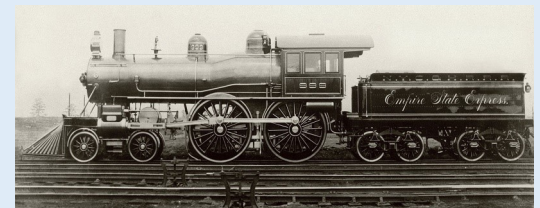
The Collinwood - Nottingham Historical Society ask us to bring the #999 engine to Remembering the Sights and Sounds of Euclid Beach Park. f

Thank you to all our members who help with the set-up, during and the clean-up after.

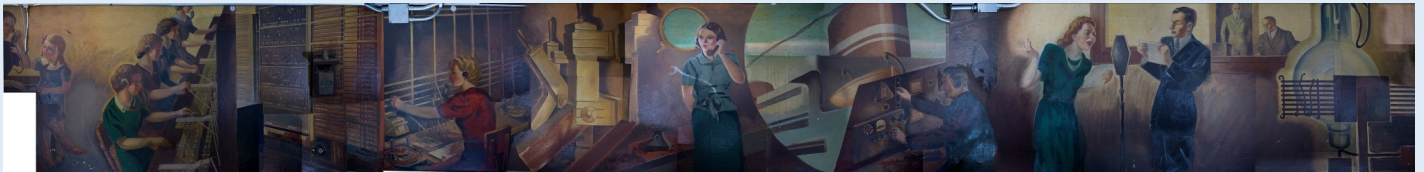


Inside the Engine Barn
