Set-up will be Thursday, March 14 at 11:30 am.





Direction to Painesville Depot I-90 (exit 200) to Rt. 44 North on Rt. 44 to Rt. 2 East on Rt. 2 (1.5 miles) to OH 535 / OH 283 (exit 223) South on OH 283 for 200 feet, left turn (east onto Chester St.) East on Chester St (0.7 miles) to North State Street South on North State Street (under RR Bridge) to Railroad Street. East on Railroad Street to Depot.
